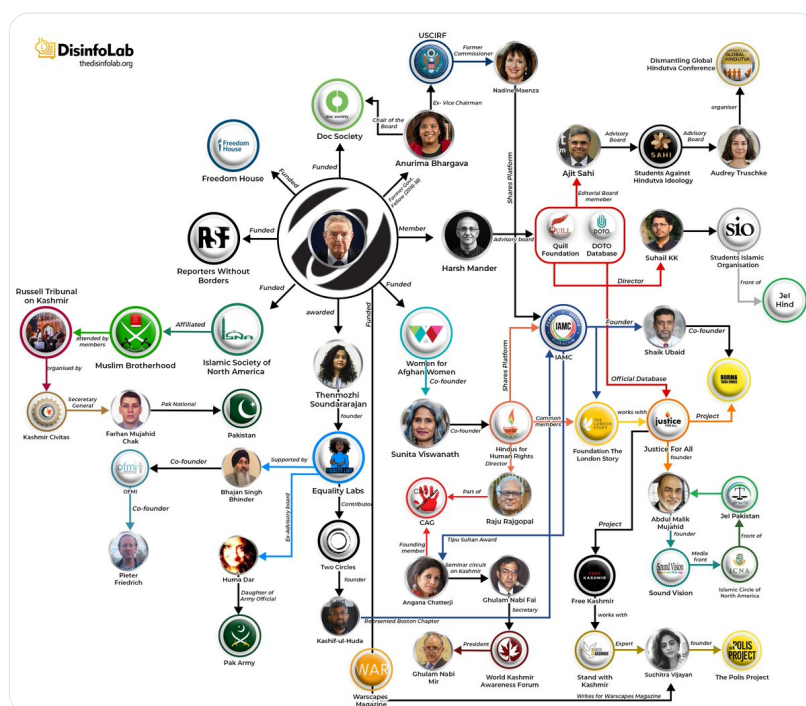




Key Personnel Changes

Benjamin Chu, a physician, has been named to the board of directors of the American Legacy Foundation. He is president of the Kaiser Foundation Health Plan and Hospitals Southern California Region and is a former president of the New York City Health and Hospitals Corporation.

Helene Gayle, who directed the Gates Foundation's HIV, TB, and Reproductive Health program through February 2006, has been named president and CEO of CARE USA, "the international poverty-fighting organization," said a December 2005 press release. She will start there in the spring of 2006. CARE USA is based in Atlanta. **Nick Hellman**, already at the Gates Foundation, has been named interim director while a search for Gayle's successor is conducted, said a prepared statement by Patty Stonesifer, cochair and president of the foundation.

Mary Johnson became vice president for communications at the United Hospital Fund in August 2005. She succeeded Phyllis Brooks, who left the fund to help run a gourmet French food company.

Sunita Mehta has been appointed executive director of Funders Concerned About AIDS (FCAA). Most recently, she was associate director of the Soros Reproductive Health and Rights Fellowship Program, which is housed at Columbia University. Mehta succeeds Derek Hodel, FCAA's interim executive director.

The Cambodian Genocide Project offered to assist in breaking the legal logjam, and with funding from the **Open Society Institute**, provided legal advice to the Cambodian government. The Coalition for International Justice convened a group of legal advisors to key missions to the U.N., who drafted a General Assembly Resolution that ordered the U.N.’s Office of Legal Affairs back into negotiations based on the Cambodian law. The resolution passed in December 2002, despite Amnesty International and Human Rights Watch opposition.

Caste fault line:

While caste is a major concern for Indian society, for some strange reason the poster girl for Dalit discourse is US born & raised activist Thenmozhi Soundarajan (Dalit Diva), who set-up ‘Equality Labs’.

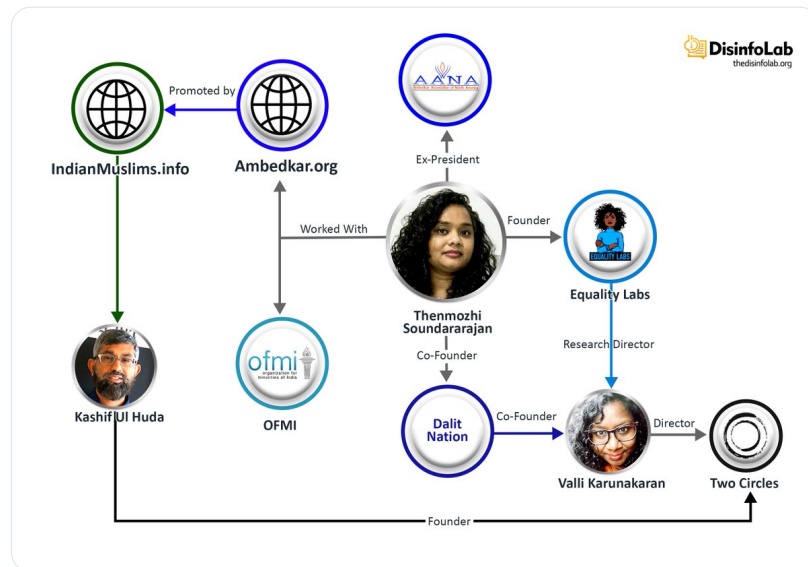

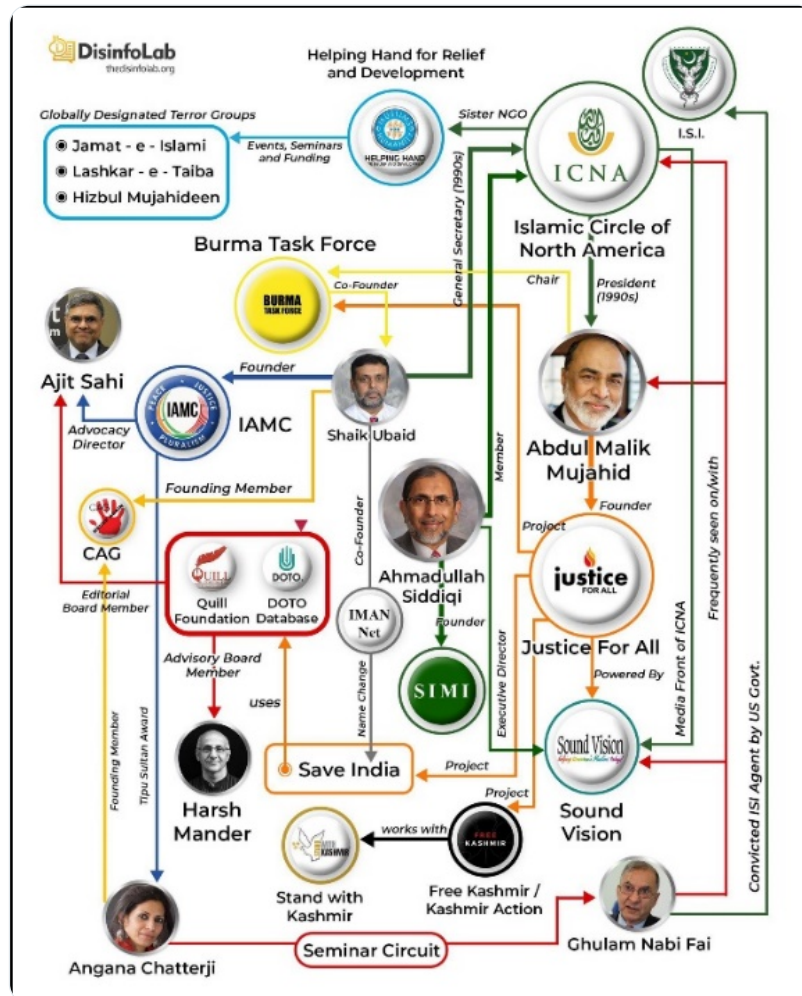
